Eligibility

The candidate should have passed 12th level examination or its equivalent with a minimum aggregate of 45% in any discipline. It is mandatory for the candidates to have pass grade in each subject of qualifying examination. A candidate having compartment in any subject will not be eligible.

1. Candidates appearing in the final examination of Class 12 are also eligible to apply provisionally for admission to the above programmes.

If an applicant is found ineligible, after admission to the college, even at a later date, his/her admission will be cancelled. All admissions will be subject to the verification from the original certificates/ documents of the candidate. The decision of the Admission Committee of the of the college regarding the eligibility of any applicant shall be final.

2. Candidates may please note that fulfilling minimum eligibility criteria does not automatically entitle a candidate to be called for counselling / admission.

Application Procedure

- Application form and prospectus can be obtained from college counter on payment on Rupees 400/- in Cash. Form and prospectus can also be obtained by post by sending a DD for Rupees 500/- in favour of Director BBM/TTM/ASPM, R.K.D. College, Patna. Application form can be filled up online also. For online applicant, computer generated receipt alongwith other documents and DD for Rs. 400/- must reach the office before the last date.
- All Correspondence regarding admission should be addressed to the Director BBM/TTM/ASPM, R.K.D. College, Patna
- 3. Documents to be submitted along with application form.
 - i. Photocopy of marks sheet of qualifying examination.
 - ii. Caste certificate (if applying against reserved quota seats.)
 - iii. NCC Certificate. (if any)
 - iv. Photographs 3 in no.

PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION

Admission will be taken only on the basis of test. The provisional selection list will contain the names of double the number of seats. List of provisionally selected students will be available on college website www.rkdcollegepatna.com and on college notice board. Selected

students will also get information through SMS/ Email. Final selection will be done after counselling. Counselling date, venue and time of counselling will be notified on college notice board and on college website. Candidates are required to bring all the documents, testimonials, marks sheet in counselling. List of finally selected students will publish one day after counselling on college notice board and on college website. Selected candidates will be required to take admission within the given time period, failing which his/her seat will be forfeited and no claim will be entertained. Seat that fall vacant will be allotted to wait listed candidates.

Note: If a candidate does not personally appear before the Admission Committee for counselling/Interview on the date and time specified, his/her seat shall be offered to the next candidate.

Following certificates and documents are required at the time of admission:

- 1. A demand draft/cash of RS.11750/-must be drawn from any Nationalised bank in favour of the Director, BCA, R.K.D. College, Patna.
- 2. Two sets of Xerox copies of all the documents attested by a Gazetted Officer.
- 3. Transfer Certificate/Migration Certificate/ evidence for Date of Birth.
- 4. Statement of marks of qualifying examination/Intermediate/Higher Secondary Education (10+2) attested by a Gazetted Officer or a person holding an equivalent rank or the Principal/Head of an Institution).

Note

Candidates must carry relevant Original Certificates and prescribed fees with them at the time of admission.

Fee deposition & Seat Confirmation

The selected candidates will have to remit the prescribed fees by way of cash or demand draft drawn in favour of Director, BCA, R.K.D. College, Payable at Patna on confirmation of the seat.

Fee once paid will not be refunded or adjusted under any circumstances.

- The college has the right to revise the fee without prior notice.
- * Change of course and subject will not be permitted.
- Any change in address should be intimated with a covering letter, 12 address slips and a Demand Draft for Rs. 100/-.
- ❖ Students are instructed to furnish necessary particulars such as Name, Address, Enrolment No./ Registration No., Year of study, in all correspondence. Letters with incomplete particulars will not be considered for action at our end.
- Whenever the students enclose demand draft for various purpose, they should write their name, enrolment number at the back of D.D.. Overwriting or correction in the demand draft will not be accepted.
- All payments such as tuition fee, for duplicate Identity cards etc. should be paid through cash/ demand draft drawn in favour of Director B.C.A., R.K.D. College, Patna.
- The place of jurisdiction for filing of suit in case of any dispute will be only at Patna.

STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICE GRIEVANCE CELL

Institute has a grievance cell for students.

Students may register their grievances / suggestions either in person or by post with the co-ordinator, BBM/TTM/ASPM. All the complaints / suggestions received will be recorded and steps will be taken to redress the grievance within a time frame. If reply is not received within a reasonable time, the fact may be brought to the notice of the Director, who will attend to it personally.

Personal Contact Program (PCP)

Code of Conduct

1) Dress Code:

For Boys: White shirt(half sleeve), Black colour trouser, Black leather shoe, White socks, Black tie, Black blazer (during winter).

For Girls: White colour sameez with 3 quarter sleeve, Black salwar, Black dupatta, Black shoe, Black blazer (during winter).

Dress should be either formal, semi formal or uniform. The way the student dress should be fit and

reflect the stature of the college. Student shall not be permitted to wear revealing clothes. Student are advised to adhere to Indian culture and ethos. Student not adhering to above rules will not be allowed to attend classes & will forfeit the attendance for the classes missed.

For repeated violation, after 3 warnings student will be suspended from attending classes for 3 days and their parents will be informed.

2) Attendance:

- Every student msut have minimum 75% aggregate attendance of the total number of lectures conducted. The student will not be eligible to appear for the examination if he / she fails to put in the required attendance. SC / ST / OBC students seeking UGC sponsored scholarship should have a minimum of 85% attendance.
- The concession in attendance is meant to take care of medical leave and leave on personal grounds.
- On duty attendance for authorized activity of the college can be granted at the discretion of the Principal.

3) Identity card and related documents:

Purpose: College urges students to understand the spirit of wearing the Identity card and to comply with rules since:

- It is a symbol of belonging to one the premier institution of the university.
- It is means of identification in the event of accident, medical and other emergencies.
- After admission and the commencement of the class each student is issued an identify card by the Administration Department.

The Identity card will contain the student's name, batch details, class, Roll No., Session, subjects offered along with a recent passport size color photograph duly stamped and signed by the college for purpose of identification.

- In case of loss of the Identity card, a duplicate Identity card will be issued on a written request subject to the approval of the Principal and payment of applicable fee. Duplicate Identity card will be clearly marked as duplicate.
- Bonafide Certificates will be issued and signed by the Principal.

Discipline

- Any act of indiscipline / insubordination or misbehaviour by any student will attract severe penalties / punishment.
- Use of mobile phones in the academic block of the college is strictly prohibited. Violation of the rule will result in confiscation of the handset.
- Appropriate disciplinary action will be taken against the student using loud / impolite talk / use of unparliamentary language.
- Students are not allowed to bring motorbike/car or any type of motorised vehicle inside the campus. Students can bring only non motorised bicycle inside the campus and will park it properly locked in the space marked for it.
- Damage to college & campus property due to negligence / lack of care would attract punishment and compensation will be charged for loss caused.
- Instigating or abetting, collective insubordination will be viewed very seriously.
- No society or association of the students will be started without written permission of the principal.
- No Social get together of students will be organized without written permission of the Principal.
- Collection of funds or sponsorship in any form will not be permitted without the written consent of the Principal.
- No person shall be invited to address or to entertain the student of the college without the prior written permission of the principal.
- Consumption or possession of alcohol / drugs smoking and being under their influence while on campus or at functions is prohibited. Appropriate disciplinary action will be taken against the defaulters.
- Theft, gambling, sexual harassment, physical fight / bouts

- with each other in the campus, indecent behaviour in public places will be dealt with severely by the college. Any other offence not included in this list will be dealt with on case to case basis.
- Littering in campus will attract either monetary or nonmonetary punishment.
- The behaviour of the student at all times within or outside the campus must be above board and must reflect a sense of responsibility. Anybody violating this would be dealt with on case to case basis by the college.
- A student who has taken admission on any form of misrepresentation of facts, or fraud will be cancelled as soon as such misrepresentation comes to surface. Further, he/she will forfeit the tuition fee paid and legal action will be taken as per the law.
- Any student misbehaving in class and behaving arrogantly towards the faculty & staff or fellow students will be severely punished. The nature of punishment will depend upon the severity of the offence and will be decided on a case-to-case basis.
- All student are required to provide accurate information relating to their local as well as permanent address and are required to intimate changes, if any, in their address.

Ragging

Anyone found indulging in ragging within or outside the campus shall be dealt with under the provisions of Ragging act, 1999. Salient features of the act are as under. Ragging within or outside any educational institute is prohibited.

Examination

- Students are required to carry Identity card & admit card during examination failing which student will not be allowed to appear for the examination.
- * Mobile phone will not be carried in the examination.
- Student using unfair means will be dealt with according to university rules.

All other rules of University will prevail

Library Rules

- Student need to follow the library rules as specified in their library card. Library is the sacred property of the college. Student should not indulge themselves into any damage to it.
- To get a book issued a student has to be present in person with his / her library card on specified days.
- Silence must be maintained in library.
- In case of loss of library card, duplicate library card can be obtained by depositing the requisite fee of Rs. 25/-.
- Only two books will be issued at a time for 15 days only. Late fine of Rs. 2/- per day will be charged, if book is not returned on time. Student will have to pay double the value of the book in case of loss of book.

Rules for Computer Lab

- Students need to follow lab rules as specified.
- Net connectivity in the computer lab for e-mailing, chatting, browsing or downloading for personal use during working hours will be considered as misconduct and punitive measures including monetary or other penalty will be invoked if found guilty.
- Any damage caused due to negligent or unprofessional behavior will result in punitive action as decided by the institute.
